Streamlining buying and invoicing process

Coventry Building Society needed to automate and streamline many of its processes. Clear visibility on organization-wide spend and improved supplier management were both essential requirements for a new procurement solution.

In particular, Coventry Building Society sought to implement an eProcurement solution so they could access the right products and services from approved suppliers, at the right place, via a secure online platform.

The organization understood that by moving all procurement activity from manual processes, through the automation of orders and invoices it would help save time and resources, and reduce user error.

As the business grew, so did the number of suppliers it worked with and as such, Coventry Building Society sought to improve management of its supply chain from the initial sourcing process all the way through to supplier relationships and risk management.

Automating procurement with security in mind

After considering seventeen different eProcurement solutions, Coventry Building Society adopted Medius' cloud-based Medius Spend Management, offering the functionality and ease of use aligned closely to the company's needs.
